1. Message from the WFKO Chairman

Dear WFKO Board Members, National Federations, and Organizations,

To all friends and members of the Fullcontact karate community around the world, I hope this message finds you in good health. Here in Japan, we are entering the rainy season. Gentle showers continue to nourish the streets, and the humidity in the air hints at the arrival of summer. Amidst this atmosphere, we are moving forward, carrying the memories and excitement of last month’s historic tournament remain vivid in our hearts

The 1st World Fullcontact Karate Championship, held on May 31 and June 1, welcomed nearly 20,000 spectators and became a truly historic celebration that brought the Fullcontact karate world together as one. The event was not only a high-level competition among nations, but also a showcase of cultural depth and diversity, featuring Showa-era historical exhibits, pavilions highlighting the legacy of each participating federation, an energetic youth demonstration team, and a powerful kata by Ms. Ieva, a blind karateka, which deeply moved the audience.

During the same period, an international meeting was held, where eight International Technical Federations, along with regional and national federations from around the world, officially joined our alliance. As a result, the foundation of the World Fullcontact Karate Organization (WFKO) was established, now comprising dojos in 123 countries and regions, making it the largest competitive federation in fullcontact karate history.

This achievement represents the fulfillment of a long-cherished dream in our community—the formation of a unified world sports federation for fullcontact karate. It also lays a firm foundation for the pursuit of Olympic recognition in the future.

From here onward, each federation must continue to respect its own autonomy and traditions while working together to develop unified competition rules and a fair, transparent governance structure. I sincerely hope that in four years, we will once again gather on the world stage, each having nurtured our strongest athletes and further enhanced the value of fullcontact karate.

Together with our colleagues around the world, we share a mission: to pass karate down as a truly universal martial culture to the next generation. Let us continue to value our cooperation and friendship as we work toward the continued global development of fullcontact karate.

Wishing you all good health and the continued growth of your organizations, I offer this message with respect and solidarity.

WFKO Board Meeting Minutes

Agenda:

At 10:00 AM, Midori opened the meeting with a welcoming address. K. Spitaels and I. Mashinini were selected as the signatories for the meeting minutes, and the meeting transitioned to the agenda.

Agenda No. 1: Introduction of Regional Directors

- The attending directors introduced themselves and provided opening remarks.
- Koi explained the internal control issues of the North and South America regions and sought deliberation regarding the continuation of the current management system (headquarters acting as proxy governance). Similarly, he reported on the international activity restrictions applied to the Russia region and requested further deliberation.
 - ◆◆Resolution: Approval of the following 2 points.
 - ① For the North and South America regions, due to the absence of appropriate general supervisors, the headquarters will continue acting as proxy governance.
 - ② The restriction on international exchange activities in the Russia region, caused by the Ukraine-related issues, will remain in place.

Agenda No. 2: Report on the 1st World Fullcontact Karate Championship

- Koi provided a retrospective on the regional selection tournaments. Special acknowledgment was given to Spitaels for his efforts in organizing the European regional selection tournaments (EFKO) and to Makki for his coordination within the Middle East region. Additionally, the schedule and financial budget for the tournament were explained. It was reported that tournament revenues were covered by advertising income from sponsors, through the remarkable efforts of JFKO, particularly from Shinkyokushinkai. Having the company led by one of Tsukamoto's disciples (AI Avatar) as the main sponsor was also reported. Details regarding the venue, Ariake Arena, were shared, including its seating capacity of 13,000 and projections for audience turnout and ticket sales success.

Agenda No. 3: Adoption of the Provisional International Regulations

- Koi explained the purpose of the provisional international regulations draft and elaborated on its key elements. He presented materials, including the "Purpose Statement for the Draft Regulations" and the "World Fullcontact Karate Organization (WFKO) Draft Regulations," to support his explanation. To emphasize the importance of this proposal, he summarized the foundational vision of the organization through a highlighted framework displayed on the screen. He also mentioned that the expertise of M. Michel, an international lawyer, had been incorporated in the drafting process.

■WFKO incorporates two images—"Circle" and "Pyramid", and two functions—"Network" and "Structure."■

International Technical Federations (ITF), represented by organizations such as WKO, Ashihara Kai Kan, Kenbukai, IFK, KWF, WKB, and EKO, form the "Circle," which serves as a network function enabling cross-sectional and horizontal collaboration among Fullcontact karate organizations.

On the other hand, International Federations (IF) create the "Pyramid," with WFKO at its apex, Regional Federations (RF) such as JFKO, EFKO, RFKO, and AFKO, and National Federations (NF) in the intermediate layer, while the lower tier consists of ITF branches in various countries and independent dojos or clubs. This pyramid embodies a vertical structure function designed to oversee competitive systems at each hierarchical level.

Thus, the "Circle and Pyramid," as well as the "Network and Structure," coexist and complement each other, even while sometimes being contradictory. WFKO integrates both elements to achieve harmony and unification, shaping its identity over time.

◆◆Resolution: These draft regulations shall be positioned as a gentleman's agreement during the founding phase of this federation, and their adoption under this premise was approved (refer to the attached international regulation draft). Going forward, when registering the federation as a legal entity, full members and voting rights shall be formally defined.

- Koi reported on membership applications from international technical federations (World Karate Guild, International Federation of Karate, Kyokushin Kenbukai, World Kyokushin Budokai, European Karate Organization, World Karate Organization, and Ashihara Kaikan). Additionally, he reported on applications from regional federations (Europe) and national federations (Georgia, Mongolia, Pakistan [two federations], Tunisia, Kazakhstan, Sweden, Russia, Paraguay, Ukraine, Uruguay, and Namibia). After deliberation by regional directors, the federation from Pakistan (represented by Mr. Al-Hadi) was disapproved. Additionally, applications from Namibia and Tunisia's federations were sent for further review by the Africa regional director.

◆◆Resolution: Approval of membership applications from seven international technical federations and thirteen national and regional federations (refer to the attached list).

Agenda No. 4: Future Activity Policies (2nd Championship)

- Midori stated that overcoming financial challenges for this tournament was particularly difficult. Initially, the federation aimed to host the event in Olympic years to align with its goal of becoming an Olympic sport. However, due to the excessive burden borne by Shinkyokushinkai, hosting the next event in Japan appears highly unlikely. This time, the "1st World Fullcontact Karate Championship" (hosted by WFKO) was the primary event, with the "8th World Karate Championship in Weight Categories" (hosted by Shinkyokushinkai) as a secondary event. For the next time, it will have to be reversed, with the "9th World Karate Championship in Weight Categories" as the primary event and the "2nd World Fullcontact Karate Championship" as the secondary event. This matter was delegated to the Japan region (JFKO), which hosted this year's event, for further deliberation.



World Fullcontact Karate Organization (WFKO) – Draft Regulations

Chapter 1: General Provisions

(Title)

Article 1: This organization shall be called the "World Fullcontact Karate Organization" (hereinafter referred to as "the Organization").

(Headquarters)

Article 2: The headquarters of the Organization shall be located at 1-25-5 Higashi-Azabu, Minato-ku, Tokyo.

(Purpose and Activities)

Article 3: The purpose of the Organization is the sound promotion and development of full contact karate, improvement of competitive skills, and the advancement of international exchange and friendship. The Organization shall carry out the following activities:

1. Hosting and managing world and international championships;
2. Establishing international rules and regulations;
3. Approving and supervising member organizations;
4. Collaborating with and supporting national and regional federations;
5. Advocating for the inclusion of full contact karate in the Olympic Games; and
6. Undertaking other activities necessary to achieve the objectives of the Organization.

Chapter 2: Organization and Officials

(Regions)

Article 4: The Organization shall define the following eleven (11) global regions, with each region composed of national federations of the countries belonging to the region as its members:

1. Africa
2. Asia
3. Central America
4. Central Asia
5. Europe
6. Japan
7. Middle East
8. North America
9. Russia region
10. South America
11. South Pacific

(Officials)

Article 5: The Organization shall have the following Officials:

1. Chairman (1)
2. Vice Chairmen (2)
3. Senior Managing Director (1)
4. Executive Director (1)
5. Directors – 10 from Japan, 7 from Europe, 2 from Russia, and 1 from each of the remaining regions.
6. Advisors and other committee members may be appointed as needed.

(Election of Officials)

Article 6: The Chairman, Vice Chairmen, Senior Managing Director, and Executive Director shall be elected by the Board (the term will be defined in Article 10 below) from among its members. The Chairman and Executive Director must reside in Japan.

(Duties of Officials)

Article 7: The duties of officials are defined as follows:

1. The Chairman shall represent the Organization and oversee its operations.



2. Vice Chairmen shall assist the Chairman and, in the event the Chairman is incapacitated or vacant, shall assume the Chairman's duties in accordance with the order previously designated by the Chairman.
3. The Senior Managing Director shall assist the Chairman and Vice Chairmen.
4. The Executive Director shall assist the Chairman, Vice Chairmen, and Senior Managing Director, handle daily administrative affairs, and execute the matters resolved by the Board.

(Term of Office)

Article 8: The term of office for each Official shall be four (4) years in principle and reelection is allowed.

(Removal of Official)

Article 9: The Board has the right to remove an official in any of the cases down below. The decision of removal must be approved by two thirds (2/3) of the Board members. The official shall be given an opportunity to make an explanation before the resolution vote.

1. Recognition that the official is unable to perform their duties due to physical or mental incapacity.
2. Recognition that the official has violated his duties.

(Board of Directors)

Article 10: The Board of Directors (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") is the highest decision-making body of the Organization and shall be composed of the elected Directors. The Board shall resolve the following matters by a majority vote. In the event of a tie, the chair shall cast the deciding vote:

1. Approval or expulsion of the Membership (the term will be defined in Article 14 below);
2. Important matters concerning world and international championships;
3. Appointment of regional directors and special committee members; and
4. Other matters necessary for the operation of the Organization.

(Operation of the Board)

Article 11: The Board shall be convened by the Chairman. Written notice specifying the date, location, purpose, and agenda must be sent at least fourteen (14) days prior to the date of the meeting.

Article 12: The Board cannot be held without a majority of directors present. However, directors unable to attend may cast a vote in writing or delegate voting authority to another director.

Article 13: Minutes of Board meetings must include the following items:

1. Date and location of the meeting;
2. Attendee names (including notes on written or proxy votes);
3. Agenda and resolutions; and
4. Summary and outcome of discussions.

The minutes shall be signed and sealed by the chair and at least two (2) designated signatories to the Minutes.

Chapter 3: Membership

(Categories of Membership)

Article 14: The following organizations are eligible for the Membership (hereinafter referred to as “the Membership”):

1. International Technical Federations;
2. Regional Federations;
3. National Federations; and
4. Branches and Clubs under International Technical Federations.

A director(s) who is elected by the Regional Federations, a party eligible for the Membership, has a right to vote in the Board.

(Approval of Membership)

Article 15: An approval of the Membership will be granted to each of the organizations in the following manner.

1. The Membership of International Technical Federations and National Federations shall be approved by the Board.
2. The Membership of National Federations shall be approved by the Board and the board meeting held in the applicable region.
3. The Membership of Branches and Clubs under International Technical Federations shall be approved by the board meetings held in the applicable nation and region.

(Criteria for the Membership)

Article 16: Organizations seeking the Membership must, in principle, meet the following criteria:

1. To support the philosophy of full contact karate and respect martial arts etiquette and manners;
2. To demonstrate stable activity and operation nationally or internationally; and
3. To possess a structure that ensures cooperative relations with other organizations.

Chapter 4: Tournaments and Competition

(Hosting the World Championship)

Article 17: The Organization shall host the World Fullcontact Karate Championship every four (4) years.

(Management of Tournaments)

Article 18: Tournaments shall be jointly managed by the Board, the national federation of the host country, and the relevant regional federation.

(Competition Rules)

Article 19: The competition shall adhere to the WFKO Competition Rules as established by the Board.

Chapter 5: Finance

(Fiscal Year)

Article 20: The fiscal year of the Organization shall begin on April 1 and end on March 31 of the following year.

(Finances)

Article 21: The Organization's expenses shall be funded through the following income sources:

1. Membership and annual fees
2. Tournament income
3. Donations and sponsorships
4. Other income

Chapter 6: Supplementary Provisions

(Enactment)

Article 22: These regulations shall come into force upon approval by the Board of Directors.

(Amendments)

Article 23: These regulations may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) majority of those present at a Board meeting.
